Re: Automobile Accident of November 22, 2010

On January 4, 2011, I arrived at your office and was greeted by a receptionist who asked me my name and to please have a seat. She offered me water or coffee. The jury went out to deliberate and returned in less than 40 minutes with a verdict. The defendant was totally liable and I had no liability at all.
